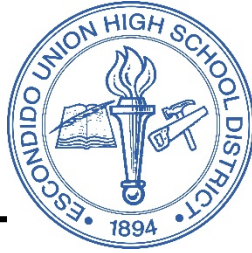

## HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE SEPTEMBER 10, 2019 BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

### ➤ Superintendent and Board Recognition

Among those highlighted include:

- **Jennifer Le**, of Orange Glen High School, was recognized as this month's Inspirational Student of the Month. Each month the EUHSD Board of Education recognizes a student who has demonstrated exemplary success - whether it is modeled through his/her academic achievements, triumph against various challenges, or standing out for their service to the school and the community.
- Valley High School Class of 2019 graduates **Maria Guerrero Acosta** received \$1000 scholarship from the Escondido Chamber of Commerce Rising Star program and **Evelyn Zamudio** received a \$500 Rising Star scholarship
- DLA senior **Estella Barriga** was part of a 3-person student team interning at California State University San Marcos this summer. The team discovered a new molecule and were able to name it. It was the first new molecule discovered by CSUSM in 22 years.
- **Valley High School** Math teacher and ASSETS coordinator **Sharon Clark** was named the California Continuation Education Association (CCEA) Teacher of the Year. The CCEA Teacher of the Year is their most prestigious award.

### ➤ Children's Hospital Los Angeles

The Board approved an agreement between Escondido Union High School District and Children's Hospital Los Angeles for Project Legacy - an adaptation of Project AIM (Adult Identity Monitoring) for homeless youth.

### ➤ Memorandum of Understanding

The Board approved several Memorandums of Understanding between Escondido Union High School District and California School Employees Association, Chapter 219; MAAC Project Head Start/Early Head Start; Education to Career Network for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA); and Education to Career Network for the Adult Education Block Grant.
