

**NOTICE TO PRE-QUALIFIED CONTRACTORS**  
**CALLING FOR INFORMAL BIDS**

(California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act)

**NOTICE:** The Escondido Union High School District of San Diego County, California, hereinafter referred to as the "District" hereby gives notice that in accordance with Public Contract Code Sections 22000-22045 the District will receive up to, but not later than **2:00pm, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021**, sealed informal bids for the following public works project:

**Description of Work:** The scope of work includes selective demolition and removal of materials and installation of new tennis court surfaces at San Pasqual High School.

**Estimated Project Cost: \$90,000.00**

**Completion of Work:** Project shall be completed by **July 31<sup>th</sup>, 2021**.

**Required California Contractor's License:** The classification of contractor's license required in the performance of this project is: **A – General Engineering, and/or C-12 – Earthwork & Paving, and/or C-69/D-47 – Tennis Court Surfacing.** Contractor must have and maintain the license throughout the duration of the project.

**Prequalification of Bidders:** As a condition of bidding for this Project, and in accordance with Uniform Construction Coast Account Procedures under Public Contract Code Section §22000 et seq, prospective bidders are required to complete in full the Districts informal bidding application. The application can be found on the EUHSD Purchasing Department website, at the following link, <https://www.euhdsd.org/departments/business-services/purchasing/cupccaa-registration/> and must be fully completed and received prior to bid opening. Bids will not be accepted if a Contractor has not been prequalified where prequalification is required. Contractors will be notified by telephone or email of their prequalification status within a reasonable period after submission of their application.

**"Mandatory" Pre-Bid Conference/Job Walk:** District will conduct a "mandatory" pre-bid conference/site walk on **Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at 9:00 AM**, San Pasqual High School, in front of Main Office, address 3300 Bear Valley Pkwy, Escondido, CA 92025. **Any bid submitted by a Bidder who does not attend the mandatory pre-bid conference shall be considered a non-responsive bid.**

**Obtaining Plans & Specifications:** Plans and Specifications for this bid will be posted on the District's website: <https://www.euhdsd.org/departments/business-services/purchasing/bids-documents-addendums/>

**Bid Security:** Each bid shall conform and be responsive to the bid plans, specifications and bid documents. Each bid submittal shall be accompanied by bid security in the form of cash, cashier's check, certified check, or bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, and made payable to the Escondido Union High School District, in the face amount of ten percent (10%) of the contract amount.

**Performance & Payment Bonds:** The successful bidder will be required to furnish the District with a Performance Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, and a Payment Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, prior to execution of the Contract. All bonds are to be secured from a surety company that meets all of the State of

California bonding requirements, as defined in Code of Civil Procedure section 995.120, and is authorized by the State of California, and all documents required by Code of Civil Procedure section 995.660, to the extent required by law.<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to the provisions of Public Contract Code section 22300, the successful bidder may substitute certain securities for funds withheld by District to ensure his performance under the Contract. At the request and expense of the successful bidder, securities equivalent to any amount withheld shall be deposited at the discretion of District, with either District or a state or federally chartered bank, as the escrow agent, who shall then pay any funds otherwise subject to retention to the successful bidder. Upon satisfactory completion of the Contract, the securities shall be returned to the successful bidder.

**Insurance:** All bidders shall agree to obtain and maintain in full effect all required insurance with limits not less than the amounts indicated. Bidders who fail to comply with the insurance requirements of this contract may have their bids rejected as non-responsive at the election of the District.

**Prevailing Wage Rates:** The Director of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the Contract which will be awarded to the successful bidder, copies of which are available online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr>. A copy of these rates shall be posted by the successful bidder at the job site. The successful bidder, and all subcontractor(s) under the successful bidder as well as all subcontractors of any tier, shall comply with all applicable Labor Code provisions, which include, but are not limited to, registration with the DIR for the duration of the work performed on the Project, the payment of not less than the required prevailing rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract, reporting compliance to the DIR, the employment of apprentices, the hours of labor and the debarment of contractors and subcontractors.

This Project is a public work and subject to prevailing wage requirements per Labor Code §1720 *et seq.* The bidder/contractor and all subcontractors of every tier shall pay laborers performing any portion of the Project not less than the prevailing wage rate established for the labor provided. Pursuant to Labor Code §1771.4(a)(4), prevailing wage rate monitoring and enforcement shall be by the California Department of Industrial Relations ("DIR"). Each bidder must be registered with the DIR pursuant to Labor Code §1725.5 in order to be qualified to submit a bid or to perform work on this Project. Bids submitted by contractors not registered with the DIR will be rejected as non-responsive. All listed subcontractors in the bid also must be registered with the DIR at the time of bid opening. At all times during performance of the Project, the bidder/contractor and **all** subcontractors, **of any tier**, must be registered with the DIR. Bidders/contractors may register with the DIR online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/Public-Works/PublicWorks.html>.

**Award of Contract:** Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 10126 (c) (2) the District declares that the following method shall be used to determine the lowest, responsive bidder on the project: **Total Base Bid.**

**Reservation of Rights:** The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept or to reject any one or more items on a bid, or to waive any irregularities or informalities in the bids or in the bidding process. No bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

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<sup>1</sup> A payment bond must be filed for a contract involving expenditure in excess of \$25,000 (Civil Code Section 3247 (a) and may be required for contracts involving smaller expenditures at the option of the District.
